
Method, Rebate, and EV Sales Data

- Method Described in Previous Workgroup Presentation:
 - Preliminary 2021–2023 CVRP Projections: Update 3 with Additional Context
- CVRP Rebate Data: March 2010—December 2021
- EV Sales Data: March 2010–October 2021*
- Changes:
 - Added seasonality for EV sales and CVRP demand forecasts
 - CFR impact now captured in historical data
 - Board approved program changes modeled




Funding Demand Over Time





Overall EV market share also showing positive signs






Hatchback EV market share among the highest categories






SUV EV market share still well below 16% target, no truck data
